WILL NOT MAKE CHANGE AT THE CHECK-IN/REGISTRATION TABLE.

Registration: Check-ins & payment will take place at Team practice **starting 15 minutes prior to the start of each age group.** Do not show up earlier than 15 minutes as the doors will be locked until that time. All CWO Wrestling Team participants MUST be pre-registered on-line at www.columbuswrestling.org under the Registration link.

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING REQUIRED PROTOCOLS FOR WRESTLING TEAM PRACTICES:

All wrestlers must wear a mask in and out of the school and up to the point where actual wrestling instruction begins. Temperature checks will be held as wrestlers enter, any wrestlers with elevated temperatures will be asked to leave. All wresters will be required to hand sanitize when entering and exiting the Clinic.

<u>Pre-K - 2nd Grade:</u> All Pre-K - 2nd grade wrestlers will enter and exit the building through the doors on the northwest side of the high school. This is the same entrance used in the past. NO EXCEPTIONS to this policy! Please park in the northeast parking lot and use sidewalk on the north side of school for entering.

 $3^{rd} - 8^{th}$ Grade: All $3^{rd} - 8^{th}$ grade wrestlers will enter and exit the building through the doors on the west side of the high school just north of the loading docks. This is a different entrance than the one used in the past. NO EXCEPTIONS to this policy!!! Please park in one of parking lots located west and south of school.

NO PARENTS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE WRESTLING ROOM UNLESS PRE-APPROVED TO HELP AS A VOLUNTEER COACH. DUE TO COVID-19 PROTOCOLS, THERE ARE **NO** EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE.

PARENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO STAY IN THE HIGH SCHOOL DURING PRACTICE. THEY WILL ONLY BE ALLOWED TO STAY LONG ENOUGH TO DROP OFF THEIR WRESTLER AT THE CHECK IN TABLE AND ARE ALLOWED TO RETURN 5 MINUTES BEFORE THE END OF PRACTICE TO PICK THEIR CHILD UP.

PRACTICE WILL ALWAYS END ON TIME TO ACCOMMODATE THIS REQUIREMENT.

NOTE: ALL WRESTLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR BRINGING THEIR OWN WATER BOTTLES.
