Clinic is focused on folk-style wrestling covering top, bottom and neutral positions. Wrestlers of all skill levels from beginner to experienced will benefit from this clinic. All sessions will include technique, live wrestling, conditioning and competitive skill games. All techniques and skills demonstrated at each clinic date will be continuously reviewed and reinforced at each practice. The Wrestling Clinic is open to both boys and girls for all grade levels.

### PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING REQUIRED PROTOCOLS FOR THE CLINIC (see website for maps):

 $\underline{\text{Pre-K}-2^{\text{nd}}\text{ Grade (and Girls Only Clinic):}}$  Wrestlers will enter and exit the building through the doors on the northwest side of the high school. Park in the northeast parking lot and use sidewalk on the north side of school for entering.

 $3^{rd} - 8^{th}$  Grade: Wrestlers will enter and exit the building through the doors on the west side of the high school just north of the loading docks. Park in one of parking lots located west and south of school.
